## **ANONYMOUS**

This section also aims to pay tribute to Pier Giacomo Castiglioni. He was certainly the first to draw attention to the anonymous masters as skilled as the best designers. It is worth remembering that some of these models were introduced to the market on the advice of Pier Giacomo Castiglioni at a time of most intense research on design, almost if to signal to designers that sometimes it may be more fitting to choose or redesign a humbled abandoned model, bringing it back to life, than to design a new product. These objects, better than others, can help us understand how great inventions are almost always connected to everyday patience, to a manual skill learned on the job in artisan workshops over years of work over centuries of small refinements. It is a culture completely absent in architecture faculties and design schools. It is a culture suppressed also by the facile fads of cover design that lead too many professionals and students

to design without experience.
